## **SUMMARY**

Domenic Silipo portrays Sal Vincenzo Salvatore, a butcher by trade; a soul searcher by nature. Sal is a successful and respected business man, owning his own butcher shop in Bay Ridge, Brooklyn, and happily married with four wonderful children... yet, something deep inside remains unsettled.

With a brazen, street-like approach, Sal expresses his views on religion, politics, marriage and parenthood; dissects our human dependence on vices such as deceit and addictions; and challenges the integrity of such establishments as the FDA and the American Cancer Society. With each of these issues, Domenic portrays a new character, ranging from a 7 year old boy to an aging Italian woman, always returning to the lead character and narrator, Sal. Though each of these characters are affected in their own way by the issue at hand, they also bring to light, a reflection of Sal's own psyche.

In a manner that is moving, humorous, and thought-provoking, Sal wrestles with making sense of a world we too often accept at face value.

With no lighting or music cues, "Miles from Somewhere" is theatre in the rawest of forms - a lone actor on a bare stage- delivering a heartfelt and revealing exploration of the human spirit.
